RULES AND REGULATIONS

US Equestrian (Federation) Membership Agreement

"Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. In all classes wherein the rules of the USEF do not apply, the horse show management shall settle any dispute or question and the decision shall be Final. Exhibitors and other participants herein, as a condition of admission, shall consent to such methods of settlement. GR 901.9 states that:

Life, Senior Active and Junior Active Members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above, and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining, and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A Nonmember may participate as a Handler, Rider, Driver, Owner, Lessee, Agent, Coach or Trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining, Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions, upon payment of a \$45.00 Show Pass Fee. Participants in the following classes are Exempt from the requirements of this rule; 1) Leadline; 2) Exhibitions; 3) Games and Races; 4) Classes for 4-H Members; 5) Walk-Trot and Academy classes. (Academy Classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program; 6) USDF Introductory Level Tests, PAS DE DEUX and Quadrille classes; 7) NHRA endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity Classes; 9) Citizens of other nations, who have proof in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation; 10) USEA Beginner Novice Division; and 11) Assistant Handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding Classes.

US Equestrian (Federation) Entry Agreement

By entering a Federation licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of the US Equestrian /United States Equestrian Federation ("the Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as Final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, broadcasts, internet, Film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation Rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be Filed in New York State. See GR 908.4

The horse show management reserves the right to itself, to refuse, limit, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries; disqualify any riders or exhibitors thereby canceling awarded prizes/ to change any course, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to change rings or officials, to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants and to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to, or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind.

- TRAINER SPLITS: Urban Equine Events offers a service to trainers that allows the trainer to purchase shavings, feed, tack stalls, paddocks, golf carts etc. directly from the Horse Show and then split the total amount for some or all of these items and have it charged directly to their client's horse show bill. Only dollar amounts will be split (not quantities). Trainer splits will be accepted until noon on Friday (no exceptions) of each show week.
- **PARENTS:** If not accompanying minor, please send Permission for Medical Treatment (responsibility for care) w/ trainer or responsible adult.
- MEDICAL WASTE: Due to Federal Regulations, all medical waste must be separated. Receptacles are provided for disposal of hypodermic needles in aisle of barns. Failure to use them will result in a \$100 Fine. Please do not mix with manure waste or trash cans.

<u>GOLF CARTS</u> Golf carts may be available with reservation. **The supply is limited. Please reserve one early on the Stabling Reservation Form.**

USEF Rule GR1301.7. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside, will NOT be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described vehicles, as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. RING/EXHIBITOR CONDUCT:

If the courtesy circle is restricted, it shall be announced, and also be indicated on the course diagram. A corresponding barrier will be erected in the arena. **If said restrictions are not observed, the rider shall be disqualified.** Jumping orders may be posted at the in-gate. Jumping orders may be pre-posted and rolled, and would be computer generated. **Post entries will be added to the top of the jump order.** Please advise the starters &/or management of any conflicts.

MEMBERSHIP, MEASUREMENT & AMATEUR CARDS

All participants (riders, drivers, handlers, owners, trainers, coaches, agents or lessees) must present to the competition secretary a current <u>USEF/USHJA</u> membership card or copy thereof, or he/she will be assessed a \$45/USEF & \$30/USHJA (or \$75 if both USEF and USHJA) non refundable, show pass fee (non member fee). All Junior and Pony Hunters must possess and present to the horse show office, a current USEF measurement card. All Amateur Owners and Adult Amateurs must present their Amateur cards at the time of number pick up. To speed processing, **please** enclose photocopies of these cards with entries.

HORSE REGISTRATION NUMBERS

See USEF Rules GR 1101,1102. All horses competing in Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from the USHJA. Applications for Registration Numbers can be completed online at www.ushja.org or www.usef.org using the Horse Registration application form. HORSES MUST STILL BE RECORDED WITH THE USEF (EITHER LIFETIME OR ANNUAL) TO RECEIVE NATIONAL OR ZONE POINTS.

MICRO CHIPPING: Beginning in the 2019 competition year, all horses competing in USEF-licensed and/or USHJAsanctioned competitions with Hunter, Hunter Breeding, Jumper, and Hunter/Jumping Seat Equitation classes not restricted by breed will be required to be microchipped. USEF has provided education materials to competitors to learn more about microchipping and the rules (HU101, JP100, EQ103).

At competitions, exhibitors may ask to turn in a USEF Microchip Reporting Form. Please let them know they can report the microchip number directly to USEF three ways:

1. Online by signing into their My USEF My Way account and updating the horse's record.

2. Faxing to (859) 231-6662 or emailing to horseservices@usef.org the Microchip Reporting Form, which may be used to report chip numbers for multiple horses.

3. Completing the microchip field on a USEF Horse Recording/ ID Application.

The completion and submission of this form is the sole responsibility of the competitor. Competitions are not responsible for assisting with the forms. Our office will check the form to ensure accuracy and completeness once received.

SCHOOLING

SCHEDULE: Management will create and announce a schooling schedule for each day based upon weather and footing conditions. Whenever mounted, all riders <u>MUST</u> wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. **ALL HORSES & ALL NON-STAFF PEOPLE MUST LEAVE ANY AREA** upon entrance of **tractor** for ring preparation, and no additional schooling in rings <u>after tractor</u> work preparation for show, nor longeing anywhere other than designated areas, after tractor work.

Schooling Hours: On day prior to show: **11:00 AM – 6:00 PM**. On shows days rings **MAY possibly** be open for schooling over jumps for <u>1 hour</u> at the conclusion of the day's classes and/or course build in that ring. Regardless of schooling status, All Arenas will close (*if open*) 45 minutes prior to show time in the mornings.

Final Show Day: THERE WILL BE <u>NO</u> SCHOOLING IN ANY ARENAS.

Some arenas may possibly be open for schooling during other <u>designated hours</u> (at management discretion). Schooling in Rings will be limited or closed at any time, at management discretion. especially due to weather conditions.

ATTIRE AND EQUIPMENT

It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper or hunter/ jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. Exception: In Hunter or Jumper classes, adults may be allowed to remove their headgear while accepting prizes and during the playing of the National Anthem only; they must refasten their headgear prior to the lap of honor. It is compulsory for riders in Paso Fino classes, both open and breed restricted including Hunter Hack, where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM / SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. A Show Committee must bar riders without protective headgear from entering the ring for classes in which protective headgear is required and may bar any entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience. **See USEF GR 801.**

The USHJA Zone 6 Hunter Committee shall provide \$1,000 of prize money to a maximum of six (6) Handy Hunter Challenges which will be held at a limited number of competitions within the Zone. Each of these six Challenges will consist of one at 2'9" (The Children's/Adult Amateur) and one at 3'0" (The Junior/Amateur.) Participants in this class will not accrue points for the USHJA Zone Horse of the Year standings nor USHJA Stirrup Cup standings.

I. CLASS SPECIFICATIONS- CHILDREN'S/ADULT AMATEUR

III. RESTRICTIONS

1. Riders may only compete on one horse or pony per Handy Hunter Challenge.

2. Riders entered in the Handy Hunter Challenge may not cross enter into any other class held at the same competition where the height of fences exceeds 3'1" (.95m.)

3. Professionals are not eligible to compete in the Handy Hunter Challenge.

4. Horses ridden in the Handy Hunter Challenge may compete with a different rider in other classes that exceed 3'0" in height at the same competition.

5. Riders entered in either height of the Handy Hunter Challenge may not cross enter, at the same show, into a USHJA National Hunter Derby.

6. Riders may not cross enter, at the same show, between the Children's/Adult Amateur Handy Hunter Challenge and the Junior/Amateur Handy Hunter Challenge.

7. If there are fewer than 3 entries in the Children's/Adult Amateur Challenge, it may be combined with the Junior/Amateur Challenge.

I. CLASS SPECIFICATIONS- JUNIOR/AMATEUR

1. All challenges will be held as a one round Handy Hunter class.

2. A minimum of ten (10) fences shall be set at 3'0" in height with spreads not to exceed the fence height.

3. There will be three (3) high option fences set at 3'3" in height with spreads not to exceed the fence height.

4. Formal attire is requested, but not required.

5. The class must be run in accordance with HU122.6 and include at least one (1) in and out, a bending line, a long approach to a single oxer, and a trot fence. The use of natural obstacles is encour-

aged, but not mandatory.

II. ELIGIBILITY

1. Open to junior and amateur riders (certification required) whose home Zone of record is Zone 6, and who are Active members of USEF and USHJA before the start of the Handy Hunter Challenge. 2. Horses must be registered with USHJA in order to participate.

III. RESTRICTIONS

1. Riders may only compete on one horse or pony per Handy Hunter Challenge.

2. Riders entered in the Handy Hunter Challenge may not cross enter into any other class held at the same competition where the height of fences exceeds 3'7" (1.10m).

3. Professionals are not eligible to compete in the Handy Hunter Challenge.

4. Horses ridden in the Handy Hunter Challenge may compete with a different rider in other classes that exceed 3'0" in height at the same competition.

5. Riders entered in either height of the Handy Hunter Challenge may not cross enter, at the same show, into a USHJA National Hunter Derby.

6. Riders may not cross enter, at the same show, between the Children's/Adult Amateur Handy Hunter Challenge and the Junior/Amateur Handy Hunter Challenge.

7. If there are fewer than three entries in the Junior/Amateur Challenge, it may be combined with the Children's/Adult Amateur Challenge

IV. JUDGING (FOR EACH SECTION)

1. The Handy Hunter Challenge may be officiated by one (1) or two (2) USEF "R" Hunter licensed judge(s). The judge must be in good standing with the USEF and USHJA.

The Handy Hunter Challenges shall be judged and numerically scored on quality, movement, jumping style, handiness, manners and way of going. Pace and brilliance are to be rewarded, but judges should remember these horses should also exhibit suitability for the level of their rider.

3. Each horse-and-rider combination will receive a numerical base score. In addition, they will receive one point for every high option jumped without a knock down; and a Handy Bonus Score consisting of zero (0) to ten (10) points for the handiness of the round. The three scores and the total score must be announced separately.

4. The judging panel may not award the same base score to any two competitors in the class unless a competitor's score is below the cut-off score.

5. All ties will be broken by the base score of the judging panel, before adding height and/or handy bonus points.
